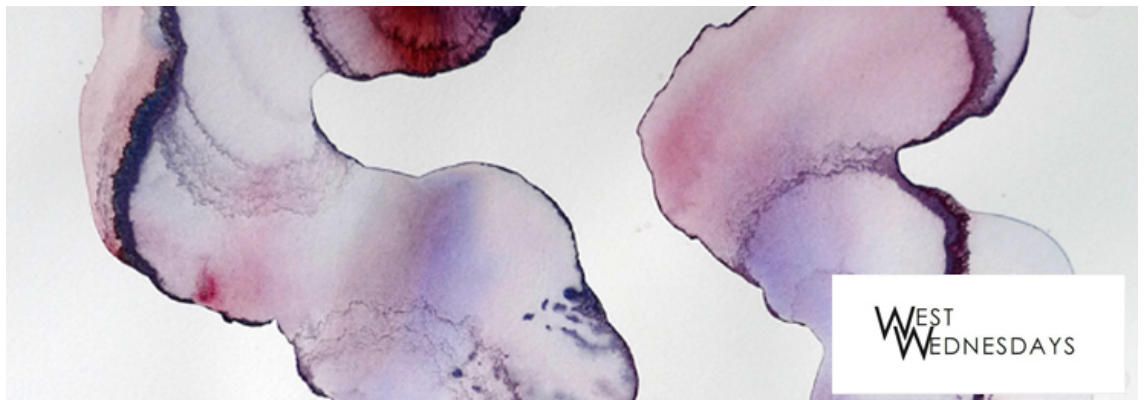

The evening will begin at 6:30pm with a curatorial talk by Rebecca Pelly-Fry, director of Griffin Gallery, and a tour of the exhibition 'Drawing Into Sculpture'. Refreshments will be served and Pelly-Fry will take questions from the group about her curatorial concerns and the artists shown. The tour will then proceed to the ACAVA Blechynden St Studios artists Barbara Nicholls and Epoch Beech will be giving a special presentation of their work in their studios.
