



## Call for Artist Proposals

### Plastic Bottle Cap Community Project – phase two

ACAVA have secured funding from Westway Trust to undertake the second phase of the North Kensington Plastic Bottle Cap Community project and we are currently seeking proposals from artists.

Born from our successful family art programme, Flourish, phase one saw the local and wider community collect approximately 40,000 unrecyclable plastic caps with a view to design and fabricate a 12 metre mural inspired by the project name: Flourish.

The outcome is a colourful, mosaic of caps which captures aspects of the ideas generated during the family design workshop. The artwork is much loved by local people and brightens up a space under the Westway and outside ACAVA's Maxilla Studios, from where the Flourish programme is delivered.



Phase two will see a second artwork, utilising plastic bottle caps, to be installed on the two adjacent sections of the railings, and will offer adults the opportunity to be involved with the project.

#### Project criteria:

- Artists applying have participatory and community based art at the heart of their practice
- The proposal for the artwork complements the existing piece
- The artwork utilises plastic bottle caps in its final outcome
- Artists will facilitate a community design/ideas workshop as well as develop and fabricate the artwork in collaboration with local participants

- Details of any DBS check you hold (if you do not have an up to date certificate we can arrange this for a fee)
- Name and contact of two referees
